ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT
TO
RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
LINN COUNTY BAR ASSOCIATION

In accordance with Section 504A.36 of the 1993 Code of Iowa, the Linn County Bar Association hereby amends its Restated Articles of Incorporation as follows:

1. The name of the corporation is Linn County Bar Association. Its effective date of incorporation was June 30, 1986.
2. The Articles of Incorporation are hereby amended by deleting Article III and substituting therefore the following:

ARTICLE III
MEMBERSHIP, DUES AND ASSESSMENTS

Any person of good character and reputation who has graduated from an accredited law school, who works or who resides in Linn County, who pays dues and assessments, if any, which are fixed from time to time by the Board of Governors, and who complies with such conditions as may be required by the Articles or the Bylaws, shall be eligible for membership upon election by majority vote of the members present at any annual, regular or special meeting of the corporation.

The Board of Governors shall have the power and authority to fix the dues and assessments, if any, to be paid by members. Such dues and assessments may vary among classes of members if the Board of Governors from time to time elects to vary dues and assessments taking into account a member's status as honorary, inactive, retired or the like. The Board of Governors may, after it has established classes of membership, vary those classes, adopt additional classes, or eliminate classes as the Board may elect.

3. At the annual meeting of the Linn County Bar Association on June 24, 1993, the amendment set forth in Paragraph 2 above was adopted by a unanimous vote of the members present, their being a quorum present at such meeting.
